
## WHAT IS THE FBA ROLE?

- Finance budget analysts play a key role in helping to inform public policy decisions, the state budget, and legislation in all areas of government such as health care, education, environmental regulation, and public safety.
- Finance develops the Governor's annual budget proposal, which outlines the Administration's policy and fiscal goals for California. Through the annual budget process, Finance Budget Analysts become policy experts in their field, responsible for advising policymakers on important issues facing California.
- After the release of the Budget in January, a Finance Budget Analyst becomes the public representative of the Administration, responsible for defending the Governor's budget proposals.
